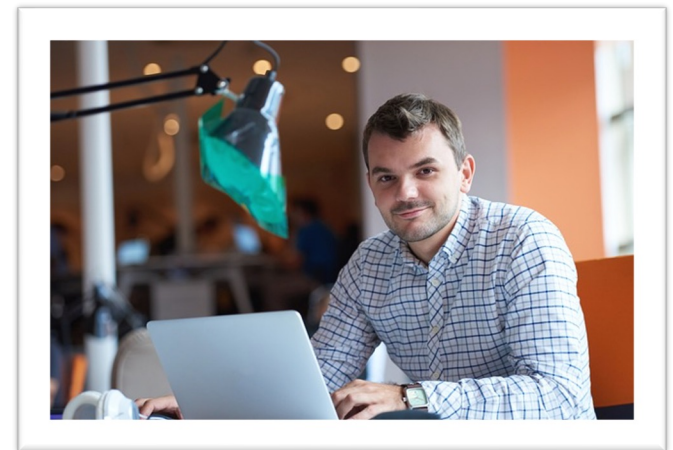


Sample Employee #1: Sam
